#### Sports Day Information...

All parents, carers, family and friends are invited to St. Peter's annual Sports Day, which is to be held on **Thursday 6th July** on St Peter's school field (weather dependent). Spectators are very welcome to enter the school grounds from 8:50am onwards and set up on the hill side of the track. You may wish to bring a blanket or a camping style chair with you so that you can watch in comfort (please be considerate of other spectator's views). Events will commence at 9:30am.
