Sports Day Information...

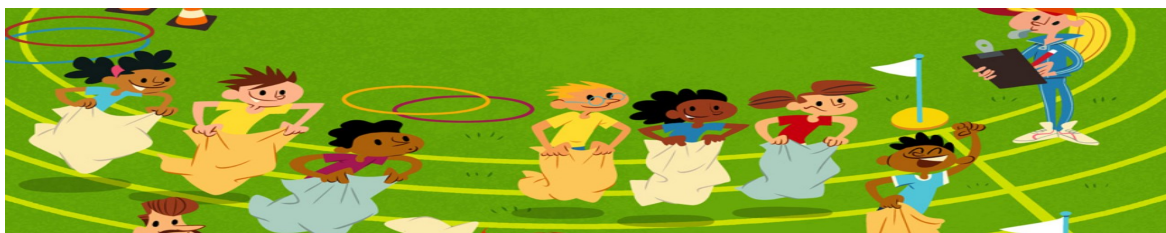
All parents, carers, family and friends are invited to St. Peter's annual Sports Day, which is to be held on **Wednesday 12th July** on St Peter's school field. This is very much weather dependent and at the moment the forecast is very on and off, so we will see how it is looking tomorrow evening. Spectators are very welcome to enter the school grounds from 8:50am onwards and set up on the hill side of the track. You may wish to bring a blanket or a camping style chair with you so that you can watch in comfort (please be considerate of other spectator's views). Events will commence at 9:30am.

Refreshments will not be on sale but **Ninja Coffee** will be here if you wish to purchase a drink. You're very welcome to bring your own flask, soft drinks and snacks!

Children will remain on their side of the track (the house side) and won't be allowed to mix with spectators during the races. At the half time interval and at the end of the event, parents will be able to see their children for a quick hug. Feel free to bring some trainers as children enjoy to watch their parents / carers / grandparents participate at the end of the children's events. There will also be a pre-school race for those that wish to participate.

Your child can come to school dressed in their sports clothes and a pair of trainers. They will need to wear the correct coloured t-shirt for their team. Your child's house team (Mark – **RED**, Matthew – **GREEN**, Luke – **YELLOW** and John – **BLUE**) is in the front of their reading record. Sun tan lotion and a sun hat may be needed if the weather is very hot. On the other hand, they may need a tracksuit top / hoodie to keep them warm in between events if the weather is not as warm.

We have no doubt that this will be an enjoyable event for all and hope you can come along to show your support and join in the fun by encouraging all children. This will be a competitive event for all, but please be supportive of all the children in our school. The morning will consist of the usual track events. Teachers will gather year group results for throwing and jumping in PE lessons before the event and these results will also go towards the overall score. On the day, children will also be awarded stickers and points for their team if they are showing the sports values of respect, team-work, determination, honesty, passion and self-belief.
